APPLICABLE ONLY WHEN LICENSED VEHICLES ARE ENTERING OR CROSSING TRAFFIC WITHOUT THE AID OF A FLAGGER.

SIGN (2) NOT NEEDED IF CROSSING OR ENTRANCE IS LOCATED WITHIN THE LIMITS OF AN ACTIVITY AREA WHERE ANOTHER SIGN (2) IS ALREADY USED.


