


Divided Highway Lane Widening or Addition



## NOTES:

SEE FIGURE 616 SIGNS AND DEVICES LEGEND AND FIGURE 616.1.2 SIGN SPACING, DEVICE SPACING.

REMOVE AND/OR MODIFY ANY EXISTING PAVEMENT MARKING AS NEEDED.

IF EXISTING LANE TRANSITION SIGNING AND PAVEMENT MARKING ARE NOT IN PLACE PRIOR TO THE BEGINNING OF THE TEMPORARY TRANSITION, TEMPORARY LANE CLOSURE SIGNING AND MARKING AS SHOWN ON FIGURE 616.0.2 LANE CLOSURE SHOULD BE PROVIDED.

PROVIDE ADDITIONAL WORK ZONE SIGNING AS REQUIRED.

SIGNING REQUIRED ON BOTH SIDES OF DIVIDED HIGHWAYS.

- (1) PAVEMENT MARKING REQUIRED WITH LONG TERM LANE CLOSURES.
- (2) FLARE BARRIER TO EXTEND BEYOND CLEAR ZONE OR FLARE BARRIER TO EDGE LINE AND USE APPROVED END TREATMENT.
